

River Kwai Discovery Wild West of Thailand 4 Days 3 Nights

Day 01: Kanchanaburi Thanlod National Park - Srinakarin (L,D)

0830 Pick up from hotel in Kanchanaburi town then depart for Thanlod National park by A/C Van or 4x4 vehicle depend on journey season.

1000 Upon arrival, start trekking into its lower cave, and appreciates the cave's splendid features. The non-touristy trail from here leads up to the upper cave, through the magnificent gallery forest along the stream that runs through the park's famous cave. Walking on a 4 kms. nature trail provides visitors a real sense of being in the tropical rainforest housing diverse species of plants and palm trees, including giant bamboo and other standing trees along the way. The trekking route is suitable for those who are physically fit. One part of the route is very steep, though wooden steps were installed to ease the walk. If you prefer you can walk cross the cave, come back then continue by car to the arrival point with beautiful scenery



1230 Reach the open cave and ultimately enjoy the tranquility of its surrounding. Have picnic lunch in the temple.

1400 Continue to Srinakarin National Park. View of the mountainous terrain on one of Kanchanaburi's most charming cross-country roads is very impressive. Reach the local jetty, crossing Srinakarin reservoir to Huai Maekamin by ferry.

1600 Check in upon arrival; enjoy walking along the nature trail and relaxing by one of the province's most beautiful Mae Kamin waterfalls. Enjoy swimming in the emerald-water.



1900 Have dinner. Overnight stay (simple with necessary facilities and electricity run until 10 pm).

Day 02: Huay Kamin Waterfall - Sangklaburi (B,L,D)

0800 After breakfast, enjoy walking along the nature trail and relaxing by one of the province's most beautiful waterfalls.

1000 Check out and depart for a scenic drive on a dirt road cutting through the forest areas (3 hours approx), then continue a journey to the borderland of Sangklaburi. Off-the-beaten track journey in this non-touristy area provides visitors an unusual experience of traveling and lots of excitements. Enjoy the forest scenery along the way. Picnic lunch served during the journey. Continue along the road with stop for scenic view.



1400 Reach Thai-Burma border "Sangklaburi" overlooking the peaceful and stunning view of the lake. Then visit Wat Wangwiwekaram [Mon Temple] golden Buddhist monastery on the opposite side after that make a stop on at the park overlooking the Wooden Bridge and Sangklaburi. Take a walk in the Mon village then cross the Wooden Bridge linking the 2 parts of Sangklaburi

- 1700 Arrival the accommodation at Ponnatee Resort (or similar) then Leisure time.
 1900 Thai dinner and overnight stay

Day 03: Sangklaburi – Pilok Valley (B,L,D)

0830 After breakfast and check out, then depart to visit the local market.

0930 Enjoy a leisure boat trip on the magnificent Khao Laem lake to the floating villages in a scenic location, 15 kms from the town. On the way, make a brief stop at the sunken temple and the Death railway under the water (if the water level is not so high that the temple remnants get entirely flooded).



1100 Get off at the local pier, continue to Thong Phapum district along the beautiful scenery of Khao Lem Lake.

1230 Lunch at local restaurant by the river in Thong Pha Phum (or similar).

1330 Stop at a local market. Shopping of food and fruits. Then a beautiful drive from here will then lead up to the highland of Pilok in the outstandingly beautiful west end of Thailand. On route, enjoy fascinating views and stop at a scenic view point overlooking the mountainous area, truly amazing.

1530 Reach Pilok and proceed to “**Glennes forest glade home**” upon arrival warm welcome by afternoon tea and homemade cakes. Then check in and leisure (or enjoy a nice chat with the owner about her extraordinary experience and the legend of Pilok mining area in its glorious era).



1900 Thai dinner in the warm atmosphere. Overnight stay.

Accommodation: a simple but nice family-run bamboo lodge with twin bedrooms, hot shower and western styled restrooms, overlooking a little creek

Day 04: Thai-Burma border - Pilok Valley (B,L,D)

Morning For those who want to have an easy day can enjoy a beautiful drive on the mountain ridge into the most stunning waterfall and all over the area.

Check out then start a journey to the westernmost of Thailand “**E-Tong view point**” the best point to lookout post between Thailand and Burma providing a magnificent view of the mountain ranges that keep the two countries apart. Then sightseeing and walk around the legendary former mining village still hidden from the eye of routine travelers for decades.



1000 Drive to Thong Pha Phum

1230 Visit Wachiralongkorn Dam and having picnic lunch there

1400 Return to Kanchanaburi town On the way you will stop at Sai Yok Noi Waterfall

16.30 Arrive Kanchaburi town
