**Day 02 BANGKOK**

**Breakfast at hotel**

**07:30-12:30 Exploring China Town with Paddle Bike and Foot Massage**

After tea and coffee from the hotel we start by exploring the bustling everyday life of Chinatown. Through narrow alleyways and winding pathways best accessed through two-wheel transport, we pass markets, local Buddhist temples and a vast array of "street life" unique. Continue to cross the Chao Phraya River by Ferry and continue the tour in Thonburi, a former capital city of Thailand. We see more local temples as well as a sample of a slower-paced lifestyle of urban Thais on this side of the river. Possible routes can also take us through Muslim communities as well as to a Christian church.



We cross the river back to Pakklong Flower Market. Continue for few steps to a massage venue. (An extra truck will take our bikes back to their original place).

**Thai Foot Massage**

Thai massage is an ancient art of body therapy for healing, health and transformation; and interactive manipulation of the body using passive stretching and gentle pressure along energy lines. These movements help to adjust the skeletal structure, increase flexibility, relieve muscular and joint tension, stimulate internal organs and balance the body's energy system. The effect is uniquely relaxing as well as energizing. Receiving a Thai massage is a bit like doing yoga without putting forth any effort while also getting acupressure treatments.

After massage, a few steps walk will bring you to the lunch venue.

**12:30-14:00 Lunch at The Deck Restaurant (Thai/Fusion)**



Located at Arun Resident, a pleasant little boutique hotel nearby Wat Po. This dining area resembles a rooftop garden and it has the most magnificent view of Wat Arun (The Temple of Dawn). The distinctive historical backdrop allows your imagination to wander whilst you sit back, enjoy the fresh air and wait for your food. Food is not far from top notch.

**14:00-17:00 Thonburi Klongs – Venice of the East**

Dubbed by Westerners at the time as the "Venice of East," Bangkok is still an enchanting city, with the local people's way of life closely aligned with the life-giving waterways. This cruise along the Chao Phraya – the city's lifeblood – and the canals of Thonburi on the east side of the river reveals scenes at odds with the bustling, modern inner city. Visitors get a glimpse



of the serene and simple lifestyle of river bank dwellers. A stop is made to visit Wat Arun, one of Bangkok's best known landmarks.

The overall winning team will be the one with the most points. Rotation is needed.

A "Survival Minimum" point score will be established as a benchmark (the number of points your team needs to score in order to have "survived").

attending ceremonies at Grand Palaces near by. The interior are superbly decorated with original antiques and Thai furnishings and a wide open air exterior to relax.

### **Chitralada Royal Projects and Arts of the King, 08:00-12:30**



This tour will take you to visit the royal project, located in Chitralada Palace, the residence of Their Majesties the King and Queen of Thailand. Its emphasis is placed on the economic and optimal utilization of the natural resources and agricultural wastes. Here, you will see the experimental rice fields, Chitralada dairy farm, Chitralada Milk Collection, Milk Tablet Plant, Saa-paper factory etc.

Later proceed to the Anantasamankom Hall (Marbel Assembly Hall) for the exhibition of the Arts of the Kingdom. Marvelous work by the students and trained staff from the SUPPORT Foundation of Her Majesty Queen Sirikit are on permanently display. The objective of the SUPPORT is to promote local arts and crafts which would assist in supplementing income for the underprivileged families. The master pieces on show included weaved Yan Li Pao basketry and complicated wooden carvings.
